Face to Face - We kicked the year off with TRANSFORMATION SEMINAR by Rhonda Hughey together with others in the city then launched 21 days of personal consecration with nightly prayer in our sanctuary and 2 other locations in the city. FACE TO FACE concluded with a night of celebration Jan 26. Returning to Cleveland March 1, 2 and 3, Rhonda Hughey met again with Independence city leaders to discuss transformation, hosted a reunion teaching night among the 8 "tribes" then met

with leaders. March 17 launched as second run of 21 days with our board participating at St. Michael's Church as Father Pete Colletti hosted FACE TO FACE opened to the city. The 8 tribes met for a night of prayer and worship again on June 29 with a night of worship set for August 8.

Our Staff worked to provide numerous opportunities to equip people in a variety of areas. Training was held for **Kid's Workers** on March 9th, as well as **Youth Worship Workshops** on March 8th and May 18th). **Synergy Conference**, a one day motivational resourcing event for

all church leaders, was attended by Vaso PD and Suhodolsky representing staff and Cherie Mosher representing the board. The Perspectives Missions Course was completed by Catherine Monnin and Cherie Mosher. On Wednesdays in June, Crescent Project's Bridges Course was held to help build bridges with Muslims in our city. On Fridays in May, Spring Life Groups were held at our building. They began with a meal, then small groups (including one for youth and children) to learn how to study, discuss and apply the Bible then teach others. (Matt. Men's Breakfasts saw 28:19). Pastor Gary Craun and Paul Mosher bring heart reaching teaching and discussion every third Saturday of the month.
